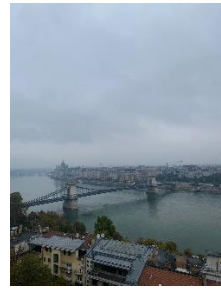
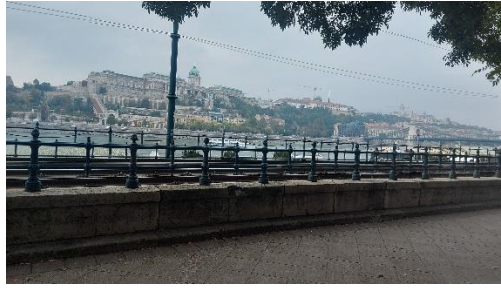


Thursday, 19.10
